A storyteller from an early age, **staci b's** artistic journey began in earnest when she left the corporate world in 1998 to become a writer. The author of seven books, Staci's been published in print and on web sites around the world and shared her stories on both cyber and real-world stages. Her newest book, *The Mermaid Queen* will be available in 2022.
